Check out the new electoral register

Residents can check if they are on the new-look electoral register to make sure they can vote in May's general and local elections.

The annually revised register was recently published and residents can check that their details are correct by visiting the Sevenoaks District Council's offices in Sevenoaks or by calling the Council on 01732 227000.

Last year the Government changed the electoral register to a system of Individual Electoral Registration replacing the previous arrangement where the 'head of household' registered everyone living in a property. This was the biggest change to electoral registration in more than 100 years. Now, each

individual is responsible for registering themselves. Most residents were automatically moved onto the new electoral register. However, some people were asked for additional details so they could join.
