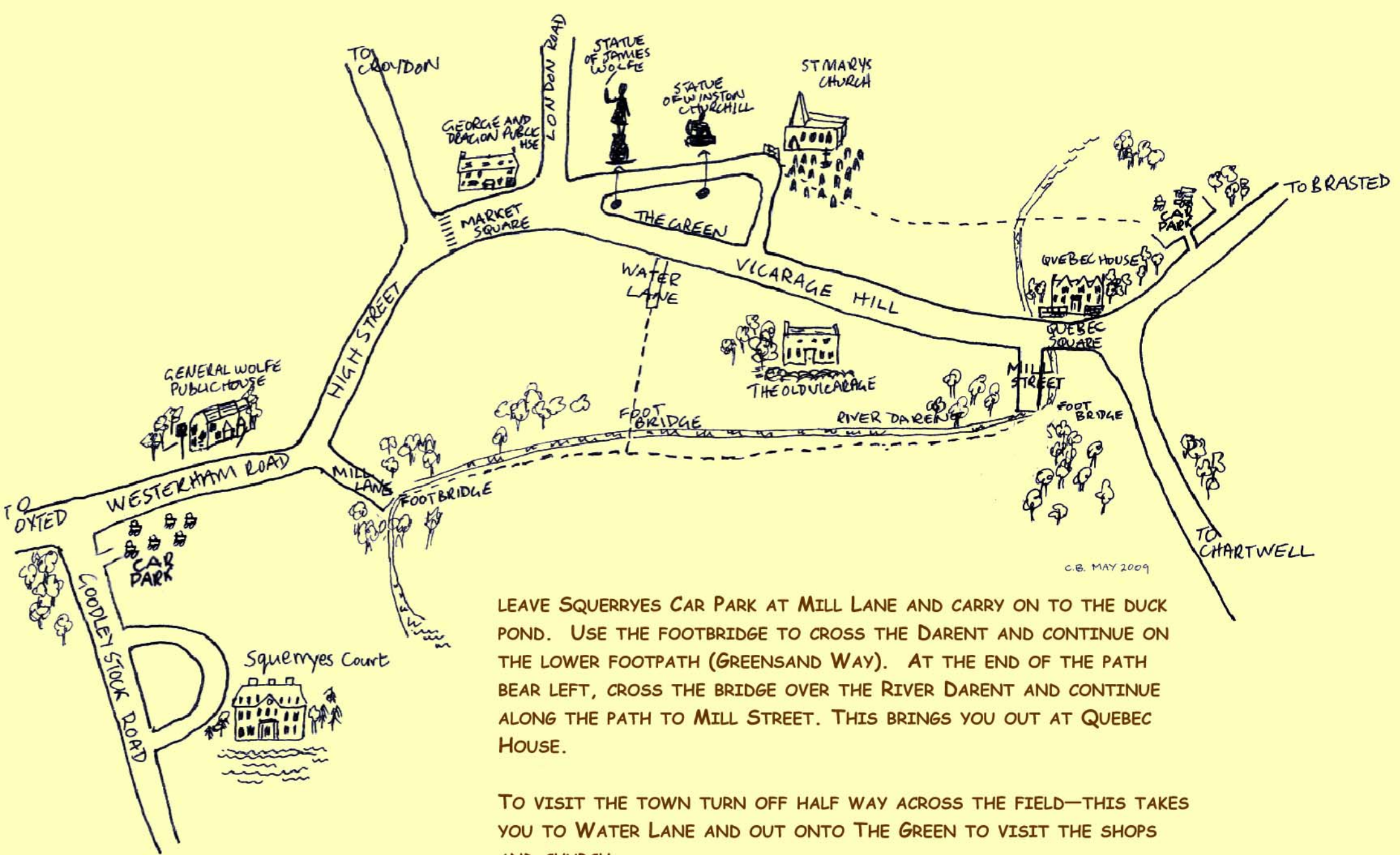

LEAVE SQUERRYES CAR PARK AT MILL LANE AND CARRY ON TO THE DUCK POND. USE THE FOOTBRIDGE TO CROSS THE DARENT AND CONTINUE ON THE LOWER FOOTPATH (GREENSAND WAY). AT THE END OF THE PATH BEAR LEFT, CROSS THE BRIDGE OVER THE RIVER DARENT AND CONTINUE ALONG THE PATH TO MILL STREET. THIS BRINGS YOU OUT AT QUEBEC HOUSE.

TO VISIT THE TOWN TURN OFF HALF WAY ACROSS THE FIELD—THIS TAKES YOU TO WATER LANE AND OUT ONTO THE GREEN TO VISIT THE SHOPS AND CHURCH.
