

Grasshopper, Moorhouse, to Westerham Hill crossing – 2.9 miles (1.4 on road, 1.5 off)

Turn left out of The Grasshopper and then left again up Clacketts Lane. At the start of a straight section just over ¼ mile after crossing the M25, turn right into a Byway indicated by a fingerpost **on the left** and follow it to Pilgrims Way. Turn right just before the road, inside the field, and walk parallel to the road to a stile and fingerpost opposite the entrance to Tatsfield Court Farm. Walk up through the farm drive to Croydon Road (B2024). Cross the road and enter the footpath between the forge and the house to its left (Halston). Follow the path uphill to the right until it reaches The Avenue outside Brambledown. Turn right and follow The Avenue to Westerham Hill.

Westerham Hill crossing to Charmans Farm, Beggars Lane – 2.7 miles (0.5 on road, 2.2 off) Family Section

Cross the road and enter the footpath (North Downs Way) opposite, following it left and uphill into and through the woods. When you exit from the woods continue along the tree line for about 200 yards and turn left up a flight of rough steps. At the top of the steps, go through a kissing gate and continue straight uphill to another kissing gate. Enter woodland, turn right and follow the path into and across a large field passing through two more kissing gates. Upon entering another large field turn right and follow the path to a broken stile on your right (this stile will not be visible until you are near it). Cross the stile and head downhill through the trees. Continue downhill through two more fields and exit onto Pilgrim's Way. Cross over and enter Force Green Lane. Follow this to the farm and, after you have passed the farmhouse on the left, turn left into a lane with a large log across the entrance (this was originally the northern end of Beggars Lane). Follow the lane and cross the M25 on a footbridge and turn left on the driveway from Beggars Lane to Charmans Farm (There is a Norvik Shipping sign at the entrance from Beggars Lane).

Charmans Farm to French Street – 2.6 miles (0.5 on road, 2.1 off)

On reaching the car park, turn right, and walk south leaving a single story black wood clad building on your left. Carry on beside the stream and enter the field. Turn right and keeping the stream on your right, follow the edge of the field until you reach a metal and wood footbridge. Follow the river, keeping it on your right, until you come to a bank and stile. Cross the stile and turn right. Walk up the tarmac road for about 75m, until you see a temporary stile over the hedge on your left. Cross it, and the field beyond until you reach another temporary stile over the fence into the allotment area. Follow the path round the allotments until you reach the car park. Cross it and enter the playing fields. Walk round them, and exit onto the A 25. Turn left and walk 250 m, until you come to a signed footpath on the right, to the left of building with black garage doors, opposite the old Bull Inn car park. Follow the wall on the left hand side to an enclosed footpath which leads uphill into a field. Follow the right hand boundary of the field to the far end and down a flight of steps onto Chart Lane (take care on these steps and watch traffic). Turn right, walk up Chart Lane for just over ¼ mile and enter Pipers Lane on your right. Go to the right of the house and follow the rough track uphill for just over ½ mile to a tarmac road at Pipers Green.

Turn right over a stile signposted to French Street and Westerham into a field. Follow the left hand boundary of the field and exit over another stile into woodland. At a cross path after 30 yards, turn left onto a path which goes down diagonally across the slope. At the bottom, cross a small stream on a sleeper bridge and walk uphill to a stile leading into a field. After the stile, go up the left hand side of the field and cross a stile to the left in the top corner. Follow the enclosed path beyond, skirting a burial ground, to another stile immediately before the checkpoint.

French Street, to Chartwell – 0.7 miles (0.1 on road, 0.6 off)

Exit onto the road, turn left and walk about 80 yards, then turn right into the path by the entrance to Mannings Wood. Follow the path round to the left behind the house and, ignoring all paths off to the right, continue ahead until you reach a road (Hosey Common Lane) in just under ½ mile. Cross the road and take the left hand of the two paths opposite. When you reach a chestnut fence at a corner, go left and downhill. Follow this path to exit onto Mapleton Road next to the Chartwell entrance.

Chartwell to Grasshopper, Moorhouse – 2.7 miles (0.7 on road, 2.0 off)

Cross the road and climb the flight of steps opposite. Take first left (path W4, great views towards Bough Beech). As path veers left and descends, take path W4 to right uphill. Follow W4 left out of wood, keeping field fence on your left. Turn right up a bank before path starts going downhill and go straight on past NT memorial, over 2 stiles and keep going until you reach a flight of steps on your left going down to the road at Froghole Corner.

Cross the road and take the path opposite. Ignore all paths to your right and continue past the houses until you reach a seat at a meeting of paths. Continue ahead, ignoring the road to the left and the paths to the right, on a path with a waymark post signing the Greensand Way on a yellow marker. When you join another path, turn left onto it then, where the path ahead has a blue Greensand Way marker on a post, take a path downhill to your left and follow it, continuing ahead at a path crossing, to Kent Hatch Road (B269). Turn right onto Kent Hatch Road, cross the end of Goodley Stock and continue until you reach a field gate on the right.

Enter the Chart, walk straight ahead to a crossing of paths with a large tree in the centre, then continue straight ahead again for some distance until you reach the meeting place of several paths. Ignore the path going back to your left and take the next one to the left, going downhill (a bridleway marked with blue arrowhead). Follow this path downhill, ignoring all side paths, until you reach Moorhouse Road. Turn right and follow the road for ½ mile to the Grasshopper. When you reach the bottom of the hill, the road bears left but you can use the path straight ahead in front of the houses.
