- THE WESTERHAM SOCIETY CANNOT BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY LOSS, INJURY OR DAMAGE ARISING OUT OF, OR CONNECTED WITH THE BEATING ON THE BOUNDS EVENT.
