## **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR WALKERS**

- THE BEATING THE BOUNDS ROUTE IS STRUCTURED TO FOLLOW PUBLIC FOOTPATHS AND RIGHT OF WAYS, AND YOU SHOULD COMPLY WITH ALL RELEVANT BYE LAWS AND REGULATIONS
- YOU SHOULD PREPARE FOR THE WALK AS YOU WOULD ON ANY PUBLIC FOOTPATH/RIGHT OF WAY
- AS WITH MANY COUNTRYSIDE PUBLIC FOOTPATHS THE ROUTE IS UNSUITABLE FOR PERSONS WITH WALKING OR OTHER DIFFICULTIES
- A PARENT OR GUARDIAN MUST SUPERVISE CHILDREN AT ALL TIMES
- THE WESTERHAM SOCIETY CANNOT BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY LOSS, INJURY OR DAMAGE ARISING OUT OF, OR CONNECTED WITH THE BEATING ON THE BOUNDS EVENT.
- YOU ARE ADVISED TO CARRY A MOBILE PHONE
- YOU ARE ADVISED TO CARRY ADEQUATE WATER FOR DRINKING
- DOGS MUST BE CONTROLLED AT ALL TIMES AND **MUST BE ON A LEAD** FOR THE SECTION FROM CHARMANS FARM TO THE A25 AND ON THE VALENCE/ DUNSDALE WHEN NEAR SHEEP AND LAMBS AND OTHER LIVESTOCK
- THERE WILL BE AN INFORMATION POINT ON THE GREEN FROM 9 am.
